## **DISCUSSION**

Cheryl Benjamin Co-Chair of the NENA Address point work group reported on the status of their work and when the initial draft is slated to be done.

Discussed the NG911WG Top Ten list that's on NSGIC's web site  
It is currently a couple of years old and should be reviewed and updated to contain more items if necessary.

A comment was made that NSGIC and NSGIC'ers should remember that the NENA processes are quite formal and somewhat insular and that if NSGIC is going to work with NENA it will be a long-term commitment and investment.

NENA membership is less than 100 bucks and it's worth joining in order to look at their GIS data model for 911 as it is in progress.

The NENA standard for getting GIS data updates to CAD dependent GIS production databases is going to be a day or less...so we should start thinking about that.
