Public-Safety Answering Point Mutual Boundary Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this __(Day)__ day of __(Month)___, _(Year), by and between <u>County A or its delegate</u> and <u>County B or its delegate</u> (hereinafter "PARTIES") situated in the State of Washington.

WHEREAS, the above PARTIES share a mutual PSAP boundary line; and,

WHEREAS, the PARTIES desire to resolve any conflicts that may arise by adjusting the mutual boundary line.

NOW, THEREFORE, the PARTIES agree as follows:

- 1. The boundary line between PARTIES is defined as such (either a physical GIS boundary or a statement of the GIS layer name, source, and creation date of the agreed upon layer [for example WA County Boundaries, DNR, 7/16/2018])
- 2. <u>County A or its delegate</u> does hereby agree to not alter or change their mutual boundary with _ <u>County B or its delegate</u> without a new Mutual Boundary Agreement.
- 3. <u>County B or its delegate</u> does hereby agree to not alter or change their mutual boundary with <u>County A or its delegate</u> without a new Mutual Boundary Agreement.
- 4. The PARTIES will notify the Washington State Military Department State Enhanced 911 Coordination Office of the change in their common boundary,
- 5. This agreement represents the entire agreement between the PARTIES.
